STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Exempting Farmers from Regulations in Re Motor Vehicles
Used in Intrastate Traffic.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 44, § 27, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 27 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered I, to read as follows:
- 'I. Of any independent contractor transporting agricultural products or farm supplies, exclusively, for one or more owners or operators of farms.'
- Sec. 2. P. L., 1943, c. 301, ¶ (A) (9), repealed. That part of paragraph (A) designated (9) of chapter 301 of the public laws of 1943 is hereby repealed.
