**AN ACT to Eliminate Needless Duplication in Travel in State
Departments.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 14, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered XI, to read as follows:

'XI. To eliminate as far as possible needless duplication in travel and to reduce travel expenses of the state administrative departments. The state controller may make such rules and regulations as he deems necessary to accomplish such purpose.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 71, repealed. Chapter 71 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
