#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of John A. Babb, of Dixfield.

John A. Babb; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$43.70 from the general fund of the state to be paid to John A. Babb, of Dixfield, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.
