## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Overseer of Poor and Other Special Officers of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 355-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 355-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 355-A. Appointment of overseer of poor and other special officers. The overseer of poor and other special officers of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians shall be appointed by the governor of the tribe with the approval of his council.'
