RESOLVE, Opening Lake Onawa to Ice Fishing Under the General Law.

Lake Onawa opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Lake Onawa in the town of Elliottsville, county of Piscataquis, to ice fishing under the general law.
