**AN ACT Relating to Interlocutory Petitions Pending Divorce Libel or
Petitions Amending Divorce Decrees.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 153, § 59-A, additional. Chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 59-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 59-A. Interlocutory petitions pending divorce libels and amending divorce decrees. Any interlocutory petition pending hearing on a libel for divorce or any petition to amend a decree of divorce may be heard and determined in term time or vacation by the court or any justice thereof, whether the petition be returnable in term time or vacation.’
