STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Judges of Municipal Courts Not to Act as Counsel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **R. S., c. 96, § 8, amended.** Section 8 of chapter 96 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 8. Judge not to act in cases within jurisdiction of his court. No judge of any municipal court shall act as counsel or attorney in any case, cause, matter, or thing which depends upon or relates to any cause exclusively cognizable by the court over which he presides, or act as counsel or attorney in any case, cause, matter, or thing, either in the municipal court over which he presides or in any other municipal court in his county which is actually brought in said court although concurrently cognizable by some other court.'
