IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Dangerous Occupations for Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 17, amended. Section 17 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new sentence to read as follows:

'No minor under 18 years of age shall be employed in, about or in connection with any manufacturing or mechanical establishment, laundry or bakery, in any capacity that the commissioner determines to be hazardous, dangerous to their lives or limbs, or where their health may be injured or morals depraved.'
