STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Personal Examination of Certain Applicants to Solicit Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 252, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 252 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided that no personal examination or examination fee shall be required of a resident of the state when applying for license to solicit accident and health insurance only casualty insurance on behalf of not more than I insurance company licensed to transact such business in this state, and provided further, that the annual premium for such each policy shall not exceed \$2.'
