AN ACT Relating to the Use Fuel Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 14, § 170, amended. The sentence defining "Person" in section 170 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended as follows:

'"Person" shall mean and include natural persons and partnerships, firms, associations, corporations, both public and private, ~~and~~ **except** municipalities.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 14, § 174, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 174 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended as follows:

'Every user, ~~except a municipality,~~ shall file with the state tax assessor a bond, as follows:'
