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### AN ACT Relating to Discharge of Chattel Mortgages and Conditional Sales of Record.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 164, § 11, amended. The last sentence of section 11 of chapter 164 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Such person or his executor, administrator or assignee, within 15 days after full payment of the money or performance of the obligation aforesaid, whether before or after breach, shall mail to the city or town clerk where the instrument is recorded, or cause to be recorded, a release or discharge of such instrument. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days.’
