### **AN ACT Relating to Registration of Truck Tractor and Semi-Trailer.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 19, § 13, amended.** The 6th paragraph of section 13 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every operator of combinations of truck tractor and semi-trailer may make application upon a blank supplied by the secretary of state ~~for a generally distinguishing number, color, or mark. The secretary of state may, if satisfied with the facts stated in the application, grant the application and issue to the applicant a certificate of registration, containing the name, place of residence, and address of the applicant, and the generally distinguishing number, color, or mark assigned to him and made in such form as the secretary of state may determine; and all semi-trailers operated by said applicant on the highway shall be regarded as registered under such generally distinguishing number, color, or mark when operated upon the highways of this state. The secretary of state shall furnish said operator with 1 number plate to be displayed on the rear of each semi-trailer so operated.'~~
