AN ACT Relating to Rate of Speed of Commercial Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 98, amended. Section 98 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 98. Rate of speed of commercial vehicles. No commercial vehicle equipped with pneumatic tires and registered to carry a load in excess of 1 ton shall be operated on open country ways at a rate of speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, or within the compact built-up portions of any city, town, or village at a rate of speed exceeding ~~40~~ 20 miles per hour; said ways and built-up portions being defined in section 102; nor shall any commercial vehicle equipped with two or more solid tires be operated on said open country ways at a rate of speed exceeding ~~45~~ 25 miles per hour or within said compact built-up portions at a rate of speed exceeding ~~40~~ 15 miles per hour.'
