# RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction at the Augusta State Hospital.

Certain construction at Augusta State Hospital. Resolved: That the sum of \$450,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the construction of:

Infirmary wing for 150 patients	\$200,000
Remodeling and fireproofing the pavilion for male	
patients	100,000
Additions and alterations to heating plant	50,000
Remodeling and additions to laundry	30,000
Equipment	45,000
Contingency	25,000
	\$450,000

at the Augusta State Hospital.

This appropriation shall not lapse and shall be carried forward from year to year until such time as the buildings are constructed and the work completed.

This construction shall begin as soon as practicable, contingent upon the availability of materials and labor.
