**AN ACT Relating to Relief During the Emergency for Businesses in
Financial Distress Because of Wartime Conditions.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1943, c. 342, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 342 of the public laws of 1943 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Duration of act. This act shall remain in force and effect only until July 1, ~~1945~~ **1947** when it shall become null and void.'
