STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Judge and the Recorder of the Westbrook Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Salary of judge. The judge of said court shall receive a salary of ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,500 per year, to be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland, which shall be in full for all his services as judge. All blanks, civil and criminal dockets and record books required by said court shall be furnished by the county of Cumberland.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 282, § 1, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 282 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Such recorder shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$400~~ \$500, in full for all services as such recorder, which salary shall be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of the county of Cumberland.'
