AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Bull Moose in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 60, amended. The 1st sentence of section 60 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall hunt, kill, transport or have in his possession any caribou or moose or parts thereof, **except that there shall be an open season on bull moose in the county of Cumberland during the last week of November, 1945, during which period any person legally licensed to hunt may hunt and kill 1 such moose not less than 1 year old and having not less than 2 prongs of not less than 3 inches in length on each horn.**'
