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**AN ACT Relating to Authority of Towns to Raise Money for Pensions for  
Town Employees.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 80, § 91, amended.** Section 91 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

**'Cities and towns may also raise money to be expended for pensions for their employees under terms and conditions as the legal voters of such cities and towns may authorize and direct.'**
