IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Androscoggin County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 79, § 151, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 151 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘The treasurer of each county, except the counties of Androscoggin, Aroostook, Cumberland, Franklin, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Penobscot, Somerset, Washington, and York shall pay annually to the treasurer of the law library association of his county, for the uses and benefits of the county law library, the sum of \$500. The treasurers of each of the following counties shall pay annually to the treasurer of the law library association of his county, for the uses and benefits of the county law library, as follows: Androscoggin, the sum of ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500; Aroostook, the sum of \$1,900, of which \$1,100 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Houlton in said county and \$800 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Caribou in said county; Cumberland, the sum of \$1,000; Franklin, the sum of \$750; Hancock, the sum of \$1,000; Kennebec, the sum of \$1,000; Knox, the sum of \$1,000; Lincoln, the sum of \$250; Penobscot, the sum of \$1,000; Somerset, the sum of \$750; Washington, the sum of \$900; York, the sum of \$1,250.’
