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**RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Pension for Henry H. Randall, of  
Rockland.**

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**Henry H. Randall; state pension. Resolved:** That Henry H. Randall, of Rockland, be credited with 4 years of service as superintendent of schools in Rockland and 17 years of service as superintendent of schools in Auburn as a state employee under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Randall has had 30 years of service as a teacher and superintendent of schools with  $27 \frac{1}{3}$  years of such service in Maine. Under a ruling of the attorney-general in November 1941, he was not considered a state employee under existing laws during the years 1903 to 1907 while superintendent of schools in Rockland and during the years 1907 to 1924 while superintendent of schools in Auburn.
