STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, in Favor of Agnes Cook, of Bangor.

Agnes Cook; made eligible to receive retirement pension. Resolved: That Agnes Cook, of Bangor, an employee of the Bangor state hospital, is hereby made eligible to receive a retirement pension at one-half pay under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes; said retirement to become effective on or before September 1, 1945.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Agnes Cook entered the employ of the Bangor state hospital on August 31, 1920. She has continued in service since and on August 31, 1945, will have completed 25 years.
