IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Construction of Addition to State Police Barracks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Construction of addition. There shall be erected under the supervision of the superintendent of public buildings a third-story addition to the state police headquarters, located on Hospital street in Augusta, in the county of Kennebec.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated \$22,500 from the general highway fund and \$2,500 from the general fund of the state for the construction of such addition.
