RESOLVE, for the Purchase of One Hundred Copies of "History of Hartford" and One Hundred Copies of "Directory of Mexico, Dixfield and Rumford".

Purchase of books. Resolved: That the state purchase 100 copies of "History of Hartford" and 100 copies of "Directory of Mexico, Dixfield and Rumford", compiled by Miss Winifred Mary Robinson, of Hartford, at a price not exceeding \$5 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the state librarian; and that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,000 for this purpose.
