STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the National Guard Association.

National Guard Association; appropriation. Resolved: That the adjutant general be, and hereby is, authorized to pay to the National Guard Association of the United States the sum of \$657 from the military fund for the support of the national guard to cover an assessment of 20c per capita made by such association; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$657 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1946, and the sum of \$657 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, from the military fund for the support of the national guard to be paid to the National Guard Association of the United States to cover an assessment of 20c per capita made by such association.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

An assessment of 20c per capita is made by the National Guard Association of the United States to safeguard the interest of the members of the National Guard in Federal service by setting up a special office in Washington to keep in touch with progress in connection with post war planning.
