IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for Location of Lookout Station on Picked Mountain in the Town of Clifton, Penobscot County.

Location of lookout station on Picked Mountain, established. Resolved: That the forest commissioner, under authority vested in him by the provisions of section 80 of chapter 32 of the revised statutes, be, and hereby is, directed to establish a lookout station on Picked Mountain in the town of Clifton, county of Penobscot.
