STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

RÉSOLVE, in Favor of a Bridge Across the St. John River.

Bridge to be constructed over St. John river. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized to build a wooden bridge across the St. John river in Allagash Plantation, at or near the "present ferry site" in cooperation with the county of Aroostook and the plantation of Allagash under the provisions of the "Bridge Act", so called.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is to take the place of the ferry which is totally inadequate for the traffic crossing this river.
