AN ACT Relating to the Reapportionment of Maintenance of Unimproved Roads and Construction of State-Aid and Third-Class Road Moneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Reapportionment of maintenance of unimproved roads and construction of state-aid and third-class road moneys. There is appropriated from the accumulated surplus of the general highway fund \$3,495,000 for the setting up of a fund for reapportionment of state-aid construction, third-class construction, and maintenance of unimproved road moneys to the municipalities of Maine. The following amounts represent the apportionment which was set up by the 1941 and 1943 legislatures:

and which was not apportioned to the municipalities by the state highway

commission with the approval of the governor with the advice and consent of his council, due to the inadvisability of construction under war-time conditions which created a shortage of labor and materials, and which has been allowed to lapse into the general highway fund, and is not available for reapportionment for the purposes originally intended under the existing laws pertaining to the highway fund.
