STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Simplify the Ice Fishing Laws by Counties.

Commissioner of inland fisheries and game to issue certain rules and regulations. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations relating to ice fishing in certain lakes, ponds, rivers, streams and brooks, as follows:

In Androscoggin county:

Open to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.

Open to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
