AN ACT Relating to Issuance of a Receipt for Payment of Poll-Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 68-A, additional. Chapter 81 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 68-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 68-A. Receipt for payment of poll-tax. In order to facilitate the issuance of motor vehicle operators' licenses and the registration of motor vehicles, the collector of taxes, or such other person as a city or town may designate, shall issue a receipt separate from any other tax payments to each person who has paid a poll-tax. If any inhabitant is exempt from payment of a poll-tax or if his said tax has been abated, the assessors of the city or town whereof he is an inhabitant shall on request issue, or cause to be issued, a certificate that he is exempt from payment of a poll-tax, or that it has been abated. Such receipt or certificate shall be either delivered or mailed to the person, so requesting, within 48 hours thereafter.'
