STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the State Liquor Commission and Appointment Thereof.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. State liquor commission and appointment thereof. The state liquor commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, to serve for 3 years or during the pleasure of the governor and council from time to time upon the expiration of the terms of office of the members, for terms of 3 years. The governor shall designate one of the members to be its chairman and not more than 2 members thereof shall belong to the same political party. Any vacancy shall be filled by appointment for a like term.'
