AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor in Glasses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 52, amended. Section 52 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 52. Containers; quantity in individual drinks. No club shall be permitted to sell spirituous or vinous liquors in the original container. **No licensee for sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises shall serve less than 1½ fluid ounces of liquor for each individual drink.'**
