IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Construct a Toll Bridge Between Old Town and Indian Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Bridge constructed; funds. A toll bridge shall be constructed between Old Town and Indian Island under the direction of the state highway commission as soon as labor and materials are available. The funds for the construction of such bridge shall be appropriated from the post war planning fund.

Sec. 2. Tolls. Tolls shall be established across such bridge at the following rates:

50c per vehicle for a round-trip;

25c per person for a round-trip;

10c for a round-trip for each Indian, except that Indian children, who attend school, shall be allowed to cross such bridge without the payment of any fee.
