**AN ACT Establishing a Forest Products and Industrial Research
Laboratory.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, §§ 118-A and 118-B, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto 2 new sections to be numbered 118-A and 118-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 118-A. Establishment of laboratory. There is established a research laboratory for the purpose of utilizing forest products resources and studying industrial problems.'

'Sec. 118-B. Supervision. Such laboratory shall be located at the University of Maine and shall be under the control and supervision of the trustees of the University of Maine.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the post war planning fund the sum of \$125,000 to build and equip a suitable laboratory for the purposes of this act. The expenditure of the appropriation shall be under the control and supervision of the trustees of the University of Maine.
