#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Mellon Hanagin, of Houlton.

Mellon Hanagin; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mellon Hanagin, of Houlton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1945 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Hanagin is 37 years of age. He has been crippled since birth, paralyzed and mentally deficient.
