AN ACT Relating to Examinations for Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Before the license is granted, an applicant shall be required to pass such physical examination and such examination by actual demonstration or otherwise as to his qualifications to operate a motor vehicle as the said secretary shall require; provided said secretary may waive such examination in the case of applicants who have been duly licensed by this state to operate a motor vehicle during any one of the 36 preceding calendar years; and no license shall be issued until the said secretary is satisfied that the applicant is a proper person to receive it.'
