IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Powers of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 16, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 16 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘They may also in any town in which a nisi prius term of the superior court is held contribute such amount as in their judgment seems proper to the repair and upkeep of any room used for the holding of such term of court **and acquire land by purchase or by condemnation proceedings for the enlargement of the grounds around county buildings.**’
