**AN ACT Relating to Powers of Attorney and Other Instruments by
Persons in the Armed Forces.**

R. S., c. 154, § 23, amended. Section 23 of chapter 154 of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by adding to the 2nd paragraph thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Provided further, that powers of attorney and other instruments requiring seals may be accepted for recordation in registries of deeds and other offices of record in cases where no seal is affixed after the name of the person or persons executing the instrument with like force and effect as though seals were affixed thereto.'
