RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Etta White of Houlton.

Mrs. Etta White; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$75 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Mrs. Etta White of Houlton, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage to her trees by beaver.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the fall of 1943, beaver dammed a brook causing damage to Mrs. White's trees (standing timber) to the extent of \$75.
