RESOLVE, in Favor of Thompson Guernsey, of Dover-Foxcroft.

Thompson Guernsey; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$214.59 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Thompson Guernsey, of Dover-Foxcroft, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident happened on December 19, 1943, in Dover-Foxcroft. Game warden Charles C. Green investigated. There was considerable damage done to Mr. Guernsey's car.
