RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Olive Clark of Bangor.

Mrs. Olive Clark; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$16.50 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Mrs. Olive Clark of Bangor, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage to her house by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A deer jumped through the window of Mrs. Clark's house causing damage to the extent of \$16.50. This matter was reported to game warden Sprague of Orono at the time of the accident on June 22, 1943.
