STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to State Aid for Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 16, amended. The 1st sentence of section 16 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be appropriated annually from the state treasury a sum of money not to exceed 2e 4c per inhabitant of the state, which shall be known as the state stipend for aid and encouragement to agricultural societies and hereafter designated as the "stipend".'
