STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Smyrna.

Town of Smyrna; interest charged off. Resolved: That the state controller be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$900.66, interest on state taxes, and the sum of \$116.25, interest on old age assistance account, now charged against the town of Smyrna for the years 1937 to 1942.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Smyrna now owes the state \$900.66 as interest on state taxes and \$116.26 as interest on old age assistance account. The town of Smyrna is heavily in debt and has no money to pay. The entire principal of the taxes to the state has been paid by such town.
