STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Bridgton Academy.

Bridgton academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Bridgton Academy the sum of \$8,000 from July 1, 1945 to June 30, 1946, and the sum of \$8,000 from July 1, 1946 to June 30, 1947, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said academy. Said amounts are to be taken from the adjustment fund as provided by subsection II of section 106 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Academy serves the purpose of a high school and does not have sufficient funds to properly function.
