STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Unemployment Compensation Law as to Collection of Contributions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 14, sub-§ (a), amended. Subsection (a) of section 14 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'(a) Interest on past-due contributions. Contributions unpaid on the date on which they are due and payable as prescribed by the commission, shall bear interest at the rate of 1% per month from and after such date until payment plus accrued interest is received by the commission; provided, however, in such cases of delinquency as are shown to the satisfaction of the commission to arise from reasonable questions of liability under the terms of this act, the commission may, in its discretion, abate not exceeding 75% of the interest herein imposed. Interest collected pursuant to this subsection shall be paid into the unemployment compensation fund.'
