AN ACT to Remove Floating Islands in Corundell Lake in Corinna.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Forest commissioner to dispose of "floating islands". The forest commissioner is authorized and directed to dispose of the "floating islands", so called, in Lake Corundell and Sebasticook Stream in the county of Penobscot in a manner to alleviate the menace to life and property in the surrounding territory.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$10,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Any unexpended balances shall lapse to the general fund.
