RESOLVE, in Favor of Fred U. Waltz, of Rockland.

Fred U. Waltz; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$159 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Fred U. Waltz, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on December 4, 1944, in West Rockport, and was investigated by Game Warden William Davis. The state police investigated the accident also. Mr. Waltz' car was badly damaged.
