STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Clerk of the Lewiston Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 128, § 1, amended. The 1st sentence of section 1 of chapter 128 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The clerk of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of \$2,100, with \$7,400 \$1,800 additional for clerk hire from said city in monthly payments, which sum shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of said clerk by law.'
