STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Purchase of Certain Equipment by the State for Use by Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 8-A. Additional powers. The commission is authorized and empowered to obtain from the federal government or any agency thereof, through purchase or gift supplies, materials and equipment which is adaptable to highway maintenance and construction. Such supplies, materials and equipment may be sold, leased or given by the commission to the several towns in the state who make a written request therefor, on such terms and conditions as the commission, in its discretion, deems necessary.'
