STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Refunding of Washington County Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1943, c. 73, amended. Chapter 73 of the private and special laws of 1943 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Bond issues authorized. The county commissioners of the county of Washington, in order to provide for the payment before, at or after the maturity of the issues of outstanding bonds of said county issued under the provisions of chapter 91 of the private and special laws of 1895 and acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto, for the purpose of refunding in whole or in part the bonds issued under the provisions thereof are hereby authorized to issue from time to time the interest bearing bonds of said county of Washington to an amount not to exceed in the aggregate at any one time outstanding \$350,000 \$500,000. Said bonds shall bear such rate or rates of interest and mature at such time or times as said county commissioners from time to time may determine. Said bonds shall be valid without first obtaining the consent of said county as provided in sections 20 26 and 21 27 of chapter 92 79 of the revised statutes of Maine.'
