IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Register of Deeds and Clerks in
the Office of Register of Deeds in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Androscoggin county is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Androscoggin, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,400.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of clerks in the office of register of deeds in Androscoggin county is hereby amended to read as follows :

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$2,500~~ \$3,400 ;
